



# Integrated Review™ (9.0.8) and JReview® (9.0.8)

## Patient Review Tracking enhancements:


- When the user (with this privilege) clicks the ‘Patient Review On’ button – three new columns appear in the list of patients in the Patient Profile Browser – which include:
  - I-Reviewed (play on words) – lets you check the checkbox when you want to tell the system you’ve reviewed that patient.
  - Review Level (dropdown listbox) – lets you set the level you’ve reviewed the patient (All, Critical or your own site defined additional levels)
  - Review Info – shows current state of the patient – Reviewed (with level, who, when), or ‘Reviewed (New Data) – with level, who, when of last review – that tells you the patient has new data, or ‘Not Reviewed’.



- If you click on a patient who has ‘Review Info’ of ‘Reviewed (New Data) ...’ the generated patient profile (either workbook or formatted profile) highlights the new rows of data – since you last reviewed – with new or updated data rows:



3. After marking some patients as being reviewed, you can apply a patient selection criteria – which retrieves only patients who have never been reviewed or have new data since you last reviewed – to focus on only new patients & new/updated data:



4. Lastly, you can use the new '\_Define Critical Panels\_' to tell the system which entire panels/modules/QGRPs are considered Critical – or just tell the system of specific Critical Items ... these can be defined and stored at the usual levels (study, project, global). Then – the new dropdown listbox in the 'Panels Included:' listbox – lets you pick one of the Critical levels – to do an instant definition of a Workbook or Formatted patient profile – which will automatically included all modules and items defined as critical:
