


## JReview® version 9.2.5 – New/Enhanced Features

### Manage/Migrate (Import/Export)

Manage/Migrate functionality incorporated into JReview client – providing easier ways of changing object categories, levels, moves, deletes, etc – using interactive filtering to select objects to be modified. Import/Export capabilities provide a mechanism to export JReview defined objects from current environment, for import into a different environment.



### Graph Patient Profiles


Added icon on generated GPP display toolbar to enable/disable Category Label (colored) headers.

Graph Patient Profile templates – now when user opens a previously defined GPP definition, and the GPP template had been updated after the GPP definition was saved, the user can remove categories included in the GPP definition, then re-add those categories – which picks up the latest

GPP template definitions. Previously, GPP definitions only had a snapshot of the GPP template that was available at the time of the GPP definition save. Now – the user has the option of keeping the original category definitions or ‘merging’ in the latest GPP template category definitions.

## Graph Browser

Added Bubble Chart – chart type:



Bar Charts – percentages – added 2 additional denominator choices – in addition to ‘All Patients’ and ‘Subset Patients’, added ‘By Val Counts’ and ‘By Val Counts in Subset’.

Scatter plots – added ‘overlapping symbols’ option checkbox – when enabled draws box around scatter points which have a number of patients represented at the same graph location.

## AE Risk Assessment

Added multi-study mode support for AE Risk Assessments.

## Formatted Patient Profiles

Previously scheduled using the PDF print server – now supports ‘Export All’ via right mouse click on the FPP output folder for the job – if PDF Print Scheduling optional module is installed.

## Dashboard Views

- Added ability to setup cache scheduling at the study level
- Added ability to set default GPP/WPP for each study – at the private, usergroup or public level
- Added ability to define Dashboard Favorites at usergroup level
- Added Dashboard Viewset level Patient Selection Criteria (which is in effect for all output displays on the selected Dashboard Viewset).
